Last year, with the help of Open Life Church and members in community of Bonney Lake, all Liberty Ridge Elementary students were provided their school supplies at no cost to them. Because over 60% of our families are experiencing significant financial hardship and qualify for free and reduced lunches, this act of kindness had an incredible impact on our families. The free and reduced lunch count at LRE significantly exceeds all but one elementary school in the Sumner School District.

We are hoping to find partners in our community to help us provide school supplies to our students again this year. Last fall parents shared stories directly and indirectly regarding the feelings of relief, support and caring toward their families by the community. The school supplies relieved a burden that many of our families are forced to deal with every fall when school starts.
